Global Development Initiative Think Tank Network

BACKGROUND

On Wednesday, September 14, 2022, Asian Institute of Eco-civilization Research and Development (AIERD) of Pakistan launched the Global Development Initiative Think Tank Network. The launch of this wide-ranging network of think tanks from several countries was spurred by the announcement of Global Development Initiative (GDI) by Chinese President Xi Jinping at the General Debate of the 76th Session of the UN General Assembly. GDI is an initiative that calls the international community to place development high on the global macro policy agenda, accelerate the implementation of the UN 2030 Agenda, and work together to steer global development towards a more balanced, coordinated, and inclusive phase.

The practical aspects of this initiative will be focused on key areas such as poverty reduction, food security, COVID-19 and vaccines, financing for development, climate change and green development, industrialization, digital economy and connectivity. This network wishes to serve as a way to lessen the division between countries and to promote collaboration in achieving GDI as a common good, on 14th September 2022. The aims of Global Development Initiative Think Tank Network are: 1.) To facilitate collaborative research on GDI and dissemination of GDI between think tanks from several countries; 2.) Advocate GDI to the relevant stakeholders in their respective countries.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Dinna highlighted several questions about GDI, such as how little is known about GDI, especially how it will work on achieving the goals, the difficulty of how to achieve the development agendas as stated in GDI, and also whether GDI will be a repetition of existing international agendas. Despite these questions, Synergy Policies welcomed the creation of this think tanks network, and believe that further dialogue with institutions and agencies interested in GDI is inevitable and pertinent. Other than AIERD and Synergy Policies, the agenda launching of this network was attended by several think tanks comes from different countries and international universities, such as: Center for International Knowledge and Development, Schiller Institute, Center for New and Inclusive Asia, Synergy Policies, Global Governance Institute, Pakistan Center for Community with Shared Future, Pak-China Institute, Belt and Road Initiative Green Coalition Council, Institute of Global Cooperation and Understanding at Peking University, Pakistan Centre at North Minzu University, China Study Center at COMSAT University.
